



BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING Part-Time Winter Entry (Evening classes)

The Bachelor of Science degree with a major in nursing is the preferred entry level for today's professional nurse. The nursing program at Cedar Crest provides a solid foundation in nursing practice anchored in a strong liberal arts education which is essential to developing the critical thinking and communication skills needed for success.

Classes and clinicals will be held Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evenings. Additional clinical hours will vary between one weekday **OR** every other weekend. Some weekend class/clinical time are required, regardless of your clinical assignment. **Students must complete 62 credits prior to starting the nursing program. Weekend clinical space is limited and is given out based on seniority using your matriculation date. Weekend clinical time is NOT guaranteed.**
